History

The Beckenham Angels Soccer Club was formed in 2000 as the first south of the river club to specialise



in women and girls football. Since that time the club has developed an impressive history repeatedly being crowned Night Series Champions, League Champions and Womens Cup champions with our premier league team.

The Club launched a new juniors program in 2014 and acheived immediate and continued success regularly appearing in finals. Several of our players have been selected for the National Training Centre Program and the WA state teams and in both 2016 and 2017 our Girls Under 15 Division1 team were the grand final winners of the Top 4 Cup.

Philosophy

The Angels are dedicated to fostering the participation of women and girls in football and to providing a safe and secure environment in which girls can develop a life-long love of the game.

We aim to provide a development pathway for girls from juniors through to professional football for the highly talented, and into competitive social football for those who do not aspire to the highest level. Our elite team, the State Premier League team seeks to excel at the highest level.

At all levels we seek to play in line with our motto: "Loyalty, Pride and Determination".

Who are we?

Our club is run by a group of committed and passionate volunteers and we have a dedicated team of coaches incuding our senior coach, Greg Farrell, a highly experienced coach with international experience.

Jess Lindquist our Junior Coordinator is a high level player who plays in our Premier League team and in 2017 represented Australia in the Futsal World Cup. Jess is also a member of the Football West Juniors Standing Committee.

Tracey Wheeler, our dedicated goal-keeping coach is a former Matilda who repesented Australia 49 times before retiring in 2000. Tracey is also a member of the Football West Womens Standing Committee.

Who are our players?

In 2017 our players ranged in age from 11 to 40+. Our junior age players come from a range of suburbs

from Armadale in the south, to Kalamunda in the east. Most come from within the Gosnells, Canning and Kalamunda local government areas. A large number also attend specialist soccer program high schools.

Our senior players come from across the metropolitan area and from as far away as Mandurah to play with the Angels. In 2017 we had two international players come to WA to play with as Angels and we anticipate this will occur again in 2018. We also have Angels playing in the US in college programs who return to play for the club in the US off-season.



Where are we?

We play at Mills Park on Brixton Street in Beckenham. We have priority usage of this state of the art facility which was recently developed by the City of Gosnells and includes international standard synthetic pitches and professional standard night lighting. All players, regardless of age, are able to train and play on a high quality surface all year round.

Beckenham Angels Code of Conduct

Responsibility

All players, match officials and spectators are responsible for their own behaviour both on and off the field.

Violence and Abuse

There is no place for violence in our Club on or off the field and the Club will not tolerate foul or abusive language directed towards players, opponents, match officials, administrators or spectators.

Discrimination and Vilification

The Club will not accept discrimination against any person or vilification of any person on the basis of their race, gender, ethnicity or sexuality.

Players

Players are required to:

- Follow any direction from coaches and Club administrators.
- Attend training regularly and provide 24 hours notice if possible if unable to attend training or a match.
- Participate fully in all training sessions and matches and not engage in any activity that will distract or disrupt other players.
- Play by the rules at all times.
- Foster an environment of inclusivity and encouragement, offering peer support where necessary.
- Act as assistant referee (linesperson) as required.
- Assist with junior teams through coaching, assisting with training sessions, or officiating at matches.
- Participate in promotional opportunities and fund raising activities as required.
- At all times recognise that whilst in uniform or wearing the club logo they are representing the Club and should behave in manner that only reflects positively on the Club.
- Strive for professionalism in their technical and personal growth as elite female athletes.

Coaches

Coaches are required to:

- Treat all members of the team with equal respect and consideration. All players deserve equal attention and training time regardless of their ability.
- Be reasonable with demands on players' time and energy and give regard to other commitments that they may have, particularly education commitments of younger players.
- Require all players in their squad to play within the spirit of the game and will ensure that the emphasis of the team is on participation.
- Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with football including but not limited to players, opponents, coaches, officials, administrators and media.
- At all times accept official medical advice with regard to a sick or injured player.

Junior Coaches

Junior Coaches are required to abide by all general expectations of coaches and also have a particular responsibility to ensure that junior players are nurtured and that demands are appropriate to their skill level. Junior coaches are required to:

Place equal emphasis on skill development, pleasure in participation and winning.

- Encourage players to try their best without admonishing or ridiculing their attempts.
- Ensure that any physical contact with junior players is appropriate to the situation and necessary for their football development.
- Immediately raise any concerns regarding the behaviour of a junior player or the behaviour of others towards junior players with the responsible parent/guardian and the Club President.
- Ensure that where coaching is provided to junior players from persons other than the team coach, that activity is authorised by the Club.

Administrators

Administrators of the Club are required to:

• Use their best endeavours at all times to promote the interests of the Club.
